## PROTECTING GREEN SPACES



Keeping our green spaces is vitally important and shouldn't be compromised. Yet the Lib Dems are trying to sell off spaces such as Trymside and Elderberry Walk. Only the Green Party has opposed this policy from the outset. We will fight to keep our parks and open spaces for future generations.

## STANDING UP FOR YOUTH SERVICES

## CREATING MORE JOBS



We don't have to have so many people unemployed in Southmead. One way out of recession is to *create* useful jobs, in particular ones that promote energy saving.
